

Model Terms & Conditions



Naetika Academy is incredibly happy to welcome you and have you be part of our students wonderful journey, delving into the world of beauty. This document has been sent to you to make every aspect of your visit clear and to hopefully make your visit as easy as possible.

Please make sure you have carefully read the following terms and conditions and understood them fully.

What will you receive?

- Freedom to choose the colour and/or design of the nails.
- Freedom to choose the shape and length (if applicable) of the nails
- A salon quality manicure or pedicure completed to the highest of qualities under the supervision of experienced educators.
- The ability to be added to a models list to receive all model opportunities first.
- A wonderful pedicure that will leave the feet baby smooth.
- And many more opportunities for extra, for example massage.

What will be required of you?

- 18 or over.
- Must not have any skin or nail diseases.
- Must not bite or pick at the skin or nails.
- Must allow photographs to be taken of their hand/feet.
- Must have block out 3 hours or more for their appointment
- Must be respectful to the students and their respective languages.
- Preferably bring a snack and a drink
- Must allow the student or educator make to technical changes necessary



Cancellation and Deposit Terms



In some situation a deposit of £10 may be taken before the course, this however is just to guarantee a place and that you will arrive. Upon arrival this money will be returned only upon a cancellation within 24hr's of the booking will you lose your deposit or in the case of a no-show.



You booking is incredibly important for our students, if you book in but then don't come or cancel within 24hr this means our students are left without a course or practice because it is not possible to find a model within 24hrs. Please make sure that upon booking you are 100% sure you will be able to make it on the day.

FAQ

What kind of quality will you receive?

You will receive a salon quality treatment which will be assessed and supervised by the educator all the way through to guide the student through the correct steps.

Are the tools used clean?

All our instruments are disinfected and sterilised before every treatment and all instruments will be individually used on only you, any consumable items will be thrown away after the treatments.

Will photographs be taken?

When agreeing to be a model you automatically agree to have photographs taken of the works of the students for their individual portfolios. It is incredibly important for our students to have these photos so unfortunately this is non-negotiable.

Are there other model opportunities available for other courses?

We do, at Naetika, have a list of models. If you wish to be added please contact one of our educators. This list means that you will always be contacted first with any opportunities to be a model in future courses.

Further Details

1. A model must be 18 years old, have no skin or nail diseases and must not bite or pick at their nails. The models nails and skin must be in a good, standard condition. The academy may require bare nails but also in some cases nails with artificial material this will be discussed before booking.
2. You will be asked to send a photo of your nails upon booking. It is of upmost importance that, from the moment you have sent that photograph, do nothing with your nail. Do not manicure, remove the material or make any other changes toward the nails.
3. As you are a model you are going to be working with students who are not yet experienced heavily in the technique they are learning which means they are going to take longer then the usual expected time for the individual procedure. This can be upwards of 3 hours. Please make sure you have a free schedule on the day you are a model because Naetika cannot guarantee that a student may not finish in time for any appointments, or make sure to tell the educator before hand so they can roughly estimate if the student will finish in time.
4. Because of the long procedure time we recommend all models to bring food/snack and a drink, preferably water. We do have shops available near the salon and drinks in-house if this is not possible.
5. As a model you will be able to choose a colour, shape and design (if possible). However, any technical elements are non-negotiable unfortunately. This can included but is not limited too, the type of manicure, filing all the nails to the same length (if your nails are long but one is broken to a short length then all nails will have to be filled the a short length as this is technically correct, if you are a model where sculpting the nail is not possible as it does not fit into the course) and anything else the student or educator may deem necessary.
6. Just as the students must be towards you, you must be respectful and kind to all students. Also because our academy is a multi lingual one you must be ready to expect that the educator and student may communicate in a different language.
